What Is Eventing ?

“Few will ever make it to the top level, and those who do represent an elite group that are considered to be among the best athletes in the world from any sport”.



Eventing is a sport which continues to grow rapidly, attracting interest from all levels of sports enthusiasts across the globe. Eventing can be termed as an “equestrian triathlon.” It involves working with a horse, both on the flat and over fences. The three phases: dressage, endurance (or cross-country), and show jumping are sure to keep spectators on the edge of their seats with the mix of beauty, elegance, and adrenaline. Particularly the cross-country phase of competition sets eventing apart from other equestrian disciplines, where horse and rider must be incredibly in-synch to conquer massive obstacles at fast speeds, including water drops and ditches. Few will ever make it to the top level, and those who do represent an elite group that are considered to be among the best athletes in the world from any sport.

A great deal of training is involved, especially for the top level of the sport, where horses must be perfectly conditioned and riders must be in tune with their equine partner’s every move to achieve success. Men and women compete against one another on an equal playing field, making eventing one of the few sports in the world where this is the case.



About Matt Brown

As a Young Rider, Matt Brown competed through the Advanced level of Three Day Eventing with his Appaloosa “Maximum Speed,” who was his mount for the North American Young Rider CCI2* Championships in 1993.

Matt has been a lifelong student of the sport, studying under some of the most respected and experienced figures of horsemanship and upper level sport, including Derek DiGrazia, Volker Brommann and Denny Emerson. He also credits horseman and rancher George Kahrl for imparting the importance of creating a trusting relationship between horse and rider, even at the top levels of competition. Matt’s abundant natural feel, partnered with George’s teachings in horsemanship and Volker and Derek’s further instruction in classical techniques, have fused to form an integral foundation for the relationships Matt forms with his equine partners as well as his training and teaching philosophies.

In 2004, Matt and Cecily founded East West Training Stables in Matt’s hometown of Petaluma, California. Together they operated a thriving training and competition business in USEA’s Area VI until they made the tough decision in 2015 to pull up roots and relocate to Cochranville, Pennsylvania in order to pursue Matt’s dreams of joining the US Eventing Team.

Matt has competed with much success through the Four-Star level of Eventing as well as through Fourth level Dressage. Every season since 2013, Matt has been named to the USEF Eventing High Performance Training Lists. In 2016, Matt was selected as an alternate for the Rio Olympics U.S. Eventing Team. He was also a member of the United States Nations Cup Team at Aachen CICO3* where he contributed to the Team’s 6th place finish.

 Horse ownership syndication is when a group of people come together to purchase shares in a promising horse for a professional Event rider. These shares not only cover the actual cost to buy the horse, but the annual costs needed to maintain the horse. For example, if you join a horse ownership syndication that offers 10 shares, then you and 9 other people will own that Event horse and help maintain the costs of your horse on an annual basis.

 The good news is that all of these costs are predetermined, and syndications come in many affordable price ranges! Because you share costs with your fellow syndicate horse owners, you don't have to be rich to be a syndicate horse owner! The shared costs for owning and maintaining an Event horse can vary greatly and all shares are tax deductible.

Windchase True Destiny is a 2012, Chestnut Irish Sport Horse Gelding out of Sirius (Windstar's sister), by Salute the Truth. Sirius, the sister of Windstar, successfully competed through the Advanced level. Windstar carried some of the top bloodlines in Ireland in his lineage on both his dam and sire's sides. Their Thoroughbred sire, 'I'm A Star', led the Eventing world as a sire in the late 1990s and early 2000s. He produced numerous successful International Three-day Event horses, including Burghley and Badminton winner Star Appeal. His babies are athletic horses with good balance, keen intelligence, and superior jumping ability. They inherit their sire's lovely, elastic way of going and bold, scopey jump.

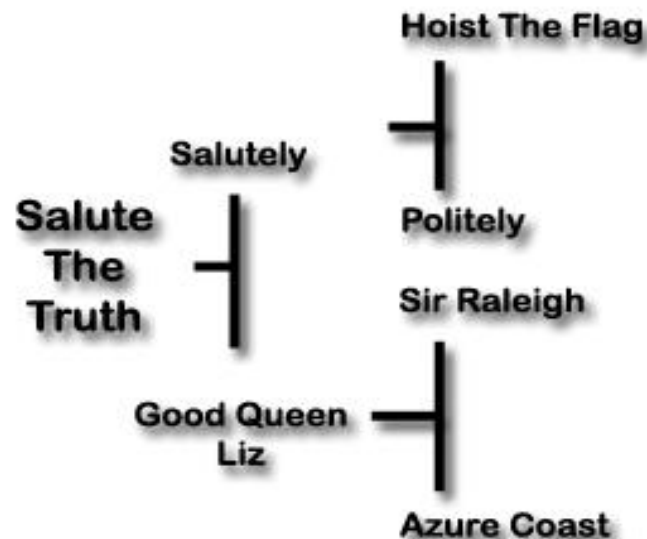

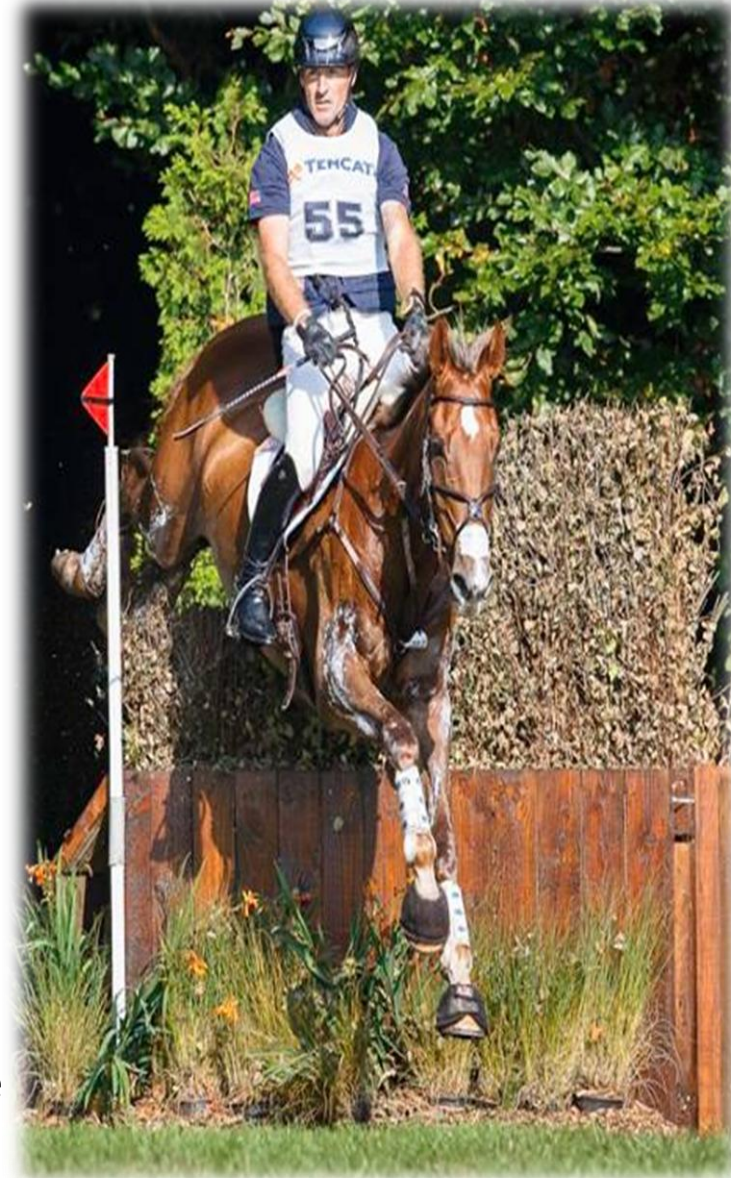
